He shared many of his solutions to the process such as sticking the belt sander into the rotating mouth of the vessel. It only jumped a few times. The lesson here is to work with the tools you have and your results will be professional. His recent vases are really cool with turquoise inlay following cracks, bark inclusions and made voids, for great effect and visual delight.
