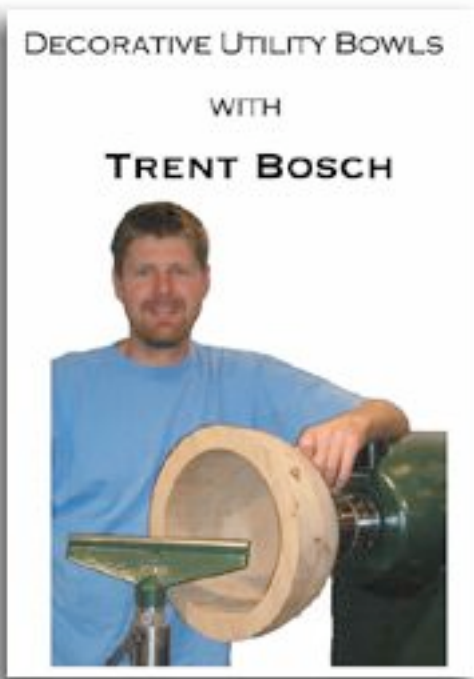

In this demo, participants will not only learn all the techniques that I go through in the creation of this body of work but how I developed it and why - making this much more than just a hollow form demo. This demonstration will include turning the outer hollow form, carving the vessel, turning the insert, using wood bending to get the insert in the outer vessel, and principals of wood bending for woodturners.
